# Trustee for The Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria

# **Trustee Report**

October 31, 2004

#### I. Introduction

1. This report provides an update to the Global Fund Board on the financial status and management of the Trust Fund for the Global Fund (the "Trust Fund") through October 31, 2004. The next section provides an overview of the financial status of the Trust Fund including information on donor contributions, grant commitments and disbursements, investment income earned and funds available for commitment. The last section discusses a number of recent developments relating to the financial management of the Trust Fund.

# II. Financial Status Report on the Global Fund Trust Fund

- 2. **Donor Contributions**: To date, the Trustee has negotiated and signed contribution agreements with 41 donors<sup>1</sup> with total contributions received in cash and notes of \$3.2 billion. Details of contributions received by donor are listed in Annex 1. In addition, there are \$265 million in signed contribution agreements, of which less than \$2 million is due to be paid in 2004, \$135 million in 2005, and the remaining in the years thereafter. See Annex II for the detailed breakdown. Contribution agreements are in process for Spain (\$50 million), Mexico (\$100,000), Poland (\$10,000) and Slovenia (approximately \$5,000). In addition, the Trust Fund has earned close to \$60 million in cumulative investment income which is available to the Trust Fund for commitment.
- 3. **Grant Commitments and Disbursements:** The Trustee commits funds based on instructions received from the Global Fund. Since inception, the Trustee has: (i) committed \$1.8 billion for grants, of which \$631 million has been disbursed (see Annex III), and (ii) committed \$98 million towards approved operating budgets, of which \$86 million has been disbursed (see Annex IV).
- 4. **Funds Available for Commitment:** Table 1 below provides the current status of funds available for commitments based on contributions received, signed grant agreements and approved operating budgets. As of October 31, 2004, net funds available for commitment towards new grant agreements and other expenses amount to \$1.33 billion. If adjustments are made for: a) the \$265 million in pending contributions from existing signed contribution agreements, and b) the \$1.27 billion in grant proposals approved in Rounds 1- 4 that have not yet been signed into grant agreements and submitted to the Trustee for commitment, the net funds potentially available for new grants and operating expenses amount to \$324 million, of which \$90 million has been set aside in a Pooled ACT account for funding of Phase 2 Malaria ACT drugs (see paragraph 9-11 under Section III).

# III. Overview of Financial Management Issues

6. The Global Fund's financial management and operating framework has continued to evolve over the past two and a half years through a series of financial and operational policy decisions as the volume and complexity of its operations have grown. Key among these is a "comprehensive funding policy" that was adopted in October 2003 which defined the components of commitment authority and authorized a voluntary replenishment mechanism which is expected to be initiated in 2005. This policy allows promissory notes to be included as an asset for the purposes of establishing commitment authority. In June 2004, the Board adopted a new policy to allow recipients to elect to have their grants denominated in either US Dollars or Euro.

### Risk Management

7. The combined effect of these policy decisions creates increased operational and financial risks that will require monitoring and management by the Global Fund. It is important that the risk management issues which have been created be adequately addressed to assure the financial soundness of the Global Fund. The Trustee continues to help the Secretariat, under MEFA oversight, in pursuing the development of an overall policy framework to manage these financial risks, including proposals to establish appropriate asset/liability management strategies to address foreign currency, credit, and liquidity risks that could arise from dual currency grants and an expected increased use of promissory notes. The risk management strategy will largely be dependent on the size and timing of the currency mismatches between the Trust Fund assets that are the basis for commitment and the dual currency grant obligations.

# Working to meet the needs of the evolving framework

- 8. The Trustee is also working closely with the Secretariat to identify and make the adjustments and improvements that are needed to accommodate this evolving framework of the Global Fund. Two recent specific examples (discussed below) are: (i) the need to accommodate the shift to ACT therapies and (ii) the special agreement with the Clinton Foundation on the procurement of AIDS medicines.
- 9. **Pooled ACT Account (set-aside):** At the 8<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting, it was agreed that special procedures were needed to accommodate the adoption of the new artemisinin-based combination therapies (ACT) in response to the latest scientific evidence concerning malaria treatment.
- 10. To operationalize the Board's decision and to clearly identify the level of funding projected to be utilized for ACT components, the Secretariat has requested the Trustee to establish a special memorandum account ("set aside") in the Trustee's business system ("Pooled ACT Account") for the funding of prospective reprogramming of malaria projects for the use of ACTs and potential Round 4 ACT requirements. The Trustee is working with the Secretariat to integrate this set aside feature within the overall systems operation to provide sufficient controls.
- 11. As of October 31, 2004, the Secretariat has instructed the Trustee to allocate a total of \$205 million to the Pooled ACT Account, of which \$90 million is for the continuation of Phase 2 funding and \$115 million for the ACT drug components within the Round 4 grants.
- 12. **Payments to Third Party:** In April 2004, the Global Fund, the World Bank, UNICEF and the Clinton Foundation entered into new agreements that will make it possible for developing countries to purchase high-quality AIDS medicines and diagnostics at the lowest available prices. To facilitate smooth implementation of this initiative, the Trustee was requested to set up a mechanism for direct payment to third parties.
- 13. The Trustee will soon put in place an interim solution to process third party payment transactions and is working on the design and development of a more permanent system solution. Similarly, we are undertaking the necessary changes to accommodate the new multi-currency grant system in time for its implementation in January 2005.

### Investment Management

- 14. As reported in the May 2004 Trustee report, a comprehensive review of the investment strategy governing the World Bank's Trust Funds portfolio has resulted in a set of revisions. The new investment strategy will see the creation of two separate portfolios: a short horizon portfolio and a longer horizon portfolio, which may see higher short term volatility but higher returns over the longer horizon. It is expected that the Global Fund resources will be placed in the longer horizon portfolio. The new investment strategy is expected to be implemented in early CY 2005. The objective of the tranching is to differentiate between trust funds with disparate risk appetites which would allow the optimization of the investment returns of both tranches subject to their respective risk tolerances and liquidity requirements.
- 15. At the 8<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting, some Board Members raised the issue of the low rate of return currently being experienced on the Trust Fund investment portfolio. In order to respond to this concern, the Trustee presented its investment management strategy to the MEFA Committee at its

October 2004 meeting and will provide a similar presentation to the Board at the November 2004 meeting.

That presentation sought to convey the message that the potential investment returns of the 16. Global Fund, as for any other fund, are determined by a combination of market conditions and the appetite for risk of the owners. Other key messages highlighted in the presentation included the following, among others: (i) there is an inherent trade-off between risk and returns - prospects for higher returns are always accompanied by greater potential for loss; (ii) risk represents the potential for loss including the possibility of not being able to get back the principal when it is needed, in other words, principal erosion; (iii) the investment objective of any fund needs to weigh three critical elements and decide among their relative priority - safety, liquidity and returns and, (iv) in case of the Trust Fund portfolio and the Global Fund, a loss of principal could adversely impact development programs and goals if sufficient funds are not available, and potentially undermine future donor support. In light of these factors, the primary investment objective of the Trust Fund portfolio is a conservative one, i.e. to protect the value of donor contributions, and to ensure that the funds are available for disbursements on a timely basis. Return enhancement is only secondary to and subject to these primary objectives. The presentation also notes that interest rates are currently low the world over and that although interest rates are likely to increase, portfolio returns will likely continue to be modest over the near term.
