- High demand in Rounds 8 and 9
- Resource gap for 2009-10
- Multiple initiatives implemented
- Replenishment, redesign of grant architecture
- Building new systems for the autonomous institution























Number of people receiving ART in low and middle-income countries, December 2008


















Global Fund HIV prevention expenditure by mid-2009 (\$840 million)




















TB financing and new sputum positive cases detected and treated, by year





Financial figures exclude disbursements to HIV/TB grant




















Total cumulative value of approved malaria grants in Rounds 1 to 8






















Global Fund portfolio, November 2009

- 57% sub-Saharan Africa
























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




















Efficiency gains achieved in Round 8 grant negotiations, September 2009


















Principal recipients, Rounds 1 to 9























Pooled procurement

- Support to countries to overcome procurement challenges and bottlenecks
- Capacity building services to strengthen country supply chain systems
- 26 countries (10 from Africa), 46 grants
- Between May and November 2009, VPP processed a total order value of \$225m (bed nets \$213m)

















Affordable Medicines Facility for malaria (AMFm)

- Increase availability and affordability of ACTs in public, private and non-government sectors
- Contribute to malaria mortality reduction
- Delay resistance to artemisinin




















THE GLOBAL FUND STRATEGY IN RELATION TO SEXUAL ORIENTATION AND GENDER IDENTITIES











Signing of Debt2Health Agreement with Germany and Pakistan, 2008


